Touristic rally exclusively for sports and prestige cars of all brands. Experience the winding roads of Corsica, with breathtaking landscapes and thrilling stages, including sections on the legendary Tour de Corse routes. Stay in 4- and 5-star hotels—this is the itinerary for this Premium Rally in Corsica!

### Stages:

#### **Friday, May 23rd: Ferry Marseille / Bastia**

Boarding in the evening around 6:00 pm at the port of Marseille, heading towards Bastia. Dinner on board, briefing, then a night in your private cabin with en-suite facilities.

#### **Saturday, May 24th: Bastia / Porto Vecchio**

Our journey begins in Bastia as we head towards Saint-Florent, a charming harbor nestled between sea and mountains. We continue through Pietralba and Morosaglia, stopping for lunch at the famous Coquillages de Diana, a floating restaurant. After a relaxing swim at the stunning Palombaggia beach, the day ends with dinner and a night's stay in a magnificent 4-star hotel for a moment of pure relaxation and comfort.

#### **Sunday, May 25th: Porto Vecchio / Olmeto**

We leave Porto-Vecchio and head towards Sartène, before crossing the mountains to reach Aullène and Petreto-Bicchisano, where we'll stop for lunch. We then continue through Grosseto-Prugna, Pietrosella, and Serra-di-Ferro, following legendary routes of the famous Tour de Corse. After passing through Porto Pollo, Sollacaro, and Casalabrice, we end the day with dinner and an overnight stay at the prestigious Marinca Hotel, for a luxurious and serene retreat.

#### **Monday, May 26th: Olmeto / Calvi**

We depart from Marinca and drive towards Afa, crossing beautiful mountain landscapes before reaching the stunning Piana cliffs, a UNESCO World Heritage Site. The striking red cliffs rise above the turquoise sea, offering breathtaking views. We continue along the coastal route towards Calvi, discovering perched villages and hidden coves along the way. The day concludes at the Corsica Spa Hotel in Calvi, where you'll enjoy a gourmet dinner and an evening of relaxation in a refined setting, with views over the sea and surrounding mountains.

#### **Tuesday, May 27th: Free Day in Calvi**

Today, enjoy a free day in Calvi to explore this beautiful town at your own pace. In the morning, stroll through the cobbled streets of the historic center, visit the citadel, and admire the stunning view of the bay from its ramparts. Afterwards, why not relax on Calvi's beach, with its fine sand and crystal-clear waters? For thrill-seekers, water sports like paddleboarding or jet-skiing are also available. For lunch, settle down at one of the seaside restaurants to savor local specialties, then spend a leisurely afternoon or opt for a boat excursion to the Scandola Nature Reserve. At sunset, enjoy an aperitif on the lively marina before finishing with dinner at a gourmet restaurant to experience the authentic flavors of Corsica. In the evening, we gather for a convivial closing dinner and a white-themed party together at the hotel.

#### **Wednesday, May 28th: Calvi / Bastia**

We leave Calvi for a final day on Corsica's scenic roads. Our first stop is L'Île-Rousse, with its charming port and colorful markets. Following the coastline, we pass through wild landscapes to reach Saint-Florent, known as the "Saint-Tropez of Corsica," where you can enjoy a coffee break on a terrace facing the yachts. We then continue to Nonza, a cliff-top village with its stone houses and unique black-pebble beach. The road winds further into Cap Corse, where we pause at Centuri, famous for its lobsters and picturesque fishermen's houses. After savoring these last spectacular views, we arrive in Bastia in the afternoon, just in time to board the ferry and conclude this magnificent journey.

Arrival in Marseille at 8:00 am. After breakfast on board, you will head back to your destination.

## Terms and Conditions for Travel Organization and Sales Activities

The activities related to the organization and sale of trips or tours are governed by law no. 92-645 of July 13, 1992 (J.O. 14.07.92) and its implementing decree no. 94-490 of June 15, 1994 (J.O. 17.06.94) and apply to the proposed trip. Any registration implies acceptance of these general terms and conditions of sale.

### 1. REGISTRATION

To participate in the proposed trip, the registration form must be returned signed along with a 40% deposit. The balance must be paid 45 days before departure. If the balance has not been paid by this date, the registration will be considered canceled and the client will be subject to the cancellation fees mentioned in section 4 of these conditions.

### 2. PRICES

Our prices are based on departure from and return to Marseille. They include the services listed under the "Included Services" section.

### 3. CANCELLATION / MODIFICATION BY THE ORGANIZER

TWINTOUR reserves the right to cancel the trip 45 days before departure due to unforeseen circumstances. Whenever possible, an alternative departure date will be offered to the participant. If the participant cannot accept the modification, the amounts paid will be fully refunded. TWINTOUR reserves the right to modify the itinerary or departure dates if required by unforeseen events. If weather conditions during the trip prevent the planned stages or require additional overnight stays, the client agrees to cover these extra costs for the duration concerned.

### 4. CANCELLATION BY THE CLIENT

In accordance with Article L.221-28-12 of the French Consumer Code, the right of withdrawal cannot be exercised for tour packages purchased remotely. In the event of cancellation, the client must inform TWINTOUR of their decision by mail. The following cancellation fees apply based on the cancellation date (postmark as proof):

- More than 60 days before departure: 20% of the total amount
- From 59 to 40 days before departure: 40% of the total amount
- From 39 to 20 days before departure: 60% of the total amount
- From 19 to 10 days before departure: 80% of the total amount
- Less than 10 days before departure: 100% of the total amount

### 5. TRANSFER OF A CONTRACT

The participant may transfer their contract to another person no later than 10 days before the start of the trip, provided the new participant meets all requirements for the trip and has signed these conditions, subject to ferry or flight tickets being transferable. This transfer will incur a fixed fee of €90, in addition to any price adjustments based on the current service costs at the time of modification. The original and new participants will be jointly responsible for paying the remaining balance.

## 6. LIMITATION OF LIABILITY

TWINTOUR is not responsible for:

- Maritime and air transport: A ferry or airline may change the departure date or time due to strikes, overbooking, technical issues, safety concerns, or weather conditions (e.g., storms, bad weather, volcanic eruptions, cyclones). In such cases, TWINTOUR cannot be held liable, and no compensation will be provided, even if this results in a delay or alteration of the planned itinerary.
- Misconduct or illegal actions of hoteliers, service providers, or their staff, causing harm to participants or their belongings.
- Force majeure: In case of interruption or cancellation due to war, uprisings, natural disasters, epidemics, fuel shortages, or other similar events, TWINTOUR will not bear the associated costs.
- Quality of accommodation: TWINTOUR cannot be held liable if the client deems the accommodation unsatisfactory.
- Loss, theft, or personal injury during the trip. The participant agrees to waive any civil or criminal proceedings against TWINTOUR.
- Road accidents or incidents caused by external factors (weather, poor road conditions, stray animals, natural disasters).
- Unpaid extras or damages caused by participants during the trip, as well as any fines incurred, which are the sole responsibility of the participant.

## 7. OBLIGATIONS OF THE PARTICIPANT

The participant is entirely responsible for their safety and that of their companions. The participant must comply with the laws and regulations of the countries visited. In the event of violation (e.g., not wearing a helmet, possession or transportation of illegal substances, exceeding legal blood alcohol levels), they will be solely responsible. They must respect speed limits and safety rules in each country. They must be experienced in driving and able to handle extended periods of driving. The participant agrees to return their vehicle to its home address, and Twintour is not responsible for the vehicle's return. The participant must present a car in perfect working order, especially concerning tires and brakes. In case of a breakdown or accident, the participant must manage the issue with their own insurance, as Twintour does not provide mechanical assistance.

If the participant takes risks deemed dangerous by the organizer or shows disrespect towards others, Twintour reserves the right to exclude them without compensation.

## 8. INSURANCE

Twintour offers participants who register more than 30 days before departure the option to subscribe to AXA group insurance to cover cancellation risks until the day of departure. Vehicle repatriation must be covered by the participant's own insurer. This insurance is available to individuals residing in mainland France, bordering European countries, or Switzerland, for 5% of the trip cost. Coverage details will be provided along with your travel documents.

## 9. COMPLAINTS

All complaints must be made by registered mail within 15 days after the trip, accompanied by the incident report provided by the local service provider. Complaints submitted by fax, phone, email, or other means, or those submitted outside this timeframe, will not be considered.

- If the trip is not paid entirely by a high-end credit card that includes medical repatriation, the participant must ensure their insurance covers this.

## 11. MISCELLANEOUS

Stages may be modified for imperative reasons or if a provider cancels or changes the scheduled services. Regarding image rights, registration for the rally implies acceptance that images of drivers, co-drivers, and vehicles may be used and exploited by the organization in any form and on any media.
